Autumn Term 1

This term, we will begin our Year 4 learning with Animals including Humans, exploring how animals survive and how humans are adapted to their environment. In History, we will travel back to Ancient Rome, while Geography will introduce us to mountains and volcanoes. In English, we will develop our writing through the journey tale Adventures at Sandy Cove and explore Alice's Adventures in Wonderland through Talk for Reading. We will also investigate place value, addition and subtraction, perimeter, and multiplication and division in Maths, alongside learning about ourselves, our differences and our aspirations through PSHE..



Autumn Term 2

In Autumn 2, our learning will take us into the world of sound, investigating how sounds are made and how they travel, while in Geography we will explore mountains and volcanoes in greater depth. English will focus on the portal story Elf Road, alongside our Talk for Reading study of Varjak Paw. In Maths, we will continue developing our understanding of multiplication and division. Across the wider curriculum, we will explore healthy diets in DT, painting in Art, repetition in Computing, and celebrating differences in PSHE, while developing our understanding of different religious beliefs and practices.
