Autumn Term 1 - a quick glance:

This half term, Year 6 will begin an exciting new year of learning across the curriculum. In English, we will explore flashback narratives through Eye of the Wolf and The Piano, alongside studying the text, 'No Ballet Shoes in Syria'. In maths, we will focus on place value within 10,000,000 and develop our understanding of the four operations.

Our science learning will investigate changing states of matter, while in history we will begin our topic on migration. Other areas of learning will include being part of our world in PSHE, interpreting sacred teachings and stories in Judaism in RE, geometric De Stijl sculpture in art, African beats in music, and football and basketball in PE.

Autumn Term 2 - a quick glance:

In English, we will explore poetry based on Ted Hughes and write a letter based on the Christmas Day Truce. We will also study the book, 'Rooftoppers'. Maths will focus on fractions and the relationship between imperial and metric measures.

In science, we will investigate forces and in geography, we will consider the question, "Is the UK's energy sustainable?" Our PSHE learning will focus on celebrating difference, and in RE we will explore how Jesus created a "New Covenant" and what this means to Christians today. We will also combine our knowledge of circuits, micro:bits and programming to create sensor alarms in D&T. Our P.E. lessons will focus on hockey and rugby.
